Adult Education Lesson: The Prophetic Timeline of Babylon and the Day of the Lord

Objective: Equip learners with the Keys of Knowledge to understand the prophetic timeline of Babylon the Great (America), the rebirth of Israel, and the Day of the Lord, as revealed in scripture and *It Is Written, Power of God* by Erick Matthew Bennett. This lesson connects historical and future events to prepare believers for the Kingdom.

Target Audience: Adults seeking to deepen their understanding of biblical prophecy and the Elect of God's mission.

Duration: 60 minutes

Lesson Outline

1. Introduction: The Keys of Knowledge and Prophecy (5 minutes)

2. Birth of Babylon the Great: America (1776) (10 minutes)

- Scripture: Revelation 13:8-18 – The number of the beast (666) is encoded in the Roman numerals MDCCLXXVI (1776) on the U.S. dollar bill, marking America's birth as Babylon the Great.

 - The dollar bill features George Washington and an Egyptian pyramid with a glowing eye, symbolizing the same powers that built Egypt, Rome, and Britain.
 - The numeric sum of MDCCLXXVI (D=500, C=100, L=50, X=10, V=5, I=1) yields 600+60+6=666, revealing America as the end-time nation of Babylon.
 - God labels America, like Egypt and Rome, as a nation of idolatry and sorcery, destined for judgment. The great pyramid of Giza with the eye of Providence as the capstone and Roman numerals on the foundation depict this.
- Discussion Question: How does the numeric structure of 1776 on the dollar bill reflect the Keys of Knowledge? (Hint: Letters to numbers)
- Visual Aid: Look at any American One Dollar Greenback.

3. Rebirth of Israel: The Lord's Temple (1917) (10 minutes)

- Scripture: Haggai 2:1 – The foundation of the Lord's temple was laid on the 24th of Chislev (December 9, 1917), when General Edmund Allenby restored Israel.
- Key Points:
 - Ezekiel 38:8 confirms Israel's rebirth by the sword, marking a pivotal moment in the Angels Timeline.
 - This event sets the stage for the countdown to the Day of the Lord, fulfilling God's promise to restore His people.
- Activity: Learners annotate a timeline with 1917, connecting it to the Angels Calendar's Post-Flood era.

4. Countdown to Judgment (1977–1997) (10 minutes)

- Scripture: Psalms 90:10 – Israel’s existence as a nation lasts 60–80 years (1977–1997), entering a period called “soon.”
- Key Points:
 - From 1917, 60 years (1977) to 80 years (1997) marks the window before the Day of the Lord, when judgment looms.
 - This period prepares the world for the prophetic events foretold by the Seven Spirits (Revelation 10:2).
- Discussion Question: Why does God use a 60–80-year timeframe to signal the approach of judgment?

5. Two Rumors: Y2K and 2012 (2000–2012) (10 minutes)

- Scripture: Jeremiah 51:46 – Two rumors of the world’s end (Y2K in 2000, Mayan calendar in 2012) precede the Day of the Lord.
- Key Points:
 - These rumors caused fear but were false, setting the stage for the true prophet, Erick Matthew Bennett, to publish *It Is Written, Power of God* in 2017.
 - Malachi 4:5 identifies this prophet as Elijah, sent before the “great and terrible day of the Lord.”
- Activity: Learners discuss how false prophecies (e.g., Y2K) differ from the true Keys of Knowledge revealed in 2017.

6. Peace and Safety: Prelude to Destruction (2019–Present) (10 minutes)

- Scripture: 1 Thessalonians 5:3 – Americans proclaim “peace and safety” (e.g., Black Lives Matter, COVID-19 safety measures), but sudden destruction follows.

- The mark of the beast (fingerprint/retina scans) will be enforced, and believers must refuse it to enter the Kingdom.
- Visual Aid: Map of New York City with annotations for prophetic destruction.

7. Sorcery and Deception: America's Fall (10 minutes)

- Scripture: Isaiah 47:9, 12; Revelation 18:23 – America's reliance on sorcery (pharmaceutical drugs) and enchantments (false prophets) blinds it to judgment.
- Key Points:
 - Sorcery (Greek: *pharmakeia ie pharmacy*) refers to antidepressants and mind-altering drugs that dull spiritual discernment.
 - Revelation 12:9 and 18:23 reveal Satan's deception through America's merchants, leading to global genocide via COVID-19 injections.
 - Daniel 7:3-4 symbolizes America as a lion (Britain) with eagle's wings (U.S.), separated by the Revolutionary War, yet destined for destruction.
- Discussion Question: How does modern "sorcery" (e.g., pharmaceuticals) parallel ancient idolatry in Babylon?

8. Conclusion: The Day of the Lord and the Elect of God (5 minutes)

- Summary: The prophetic timeline—from America's birth (1776) to the imminent Day of the Lord—reveals God's judgment on Babylon the Great. The Elect of God, through the Keys of Knowledge, prepare believers to refuse the mark of the beast and enter the Kingdom.
