



The Keys of the Kingdom: A Divine Call to Restore the True Church

In the spirit of peace and divine love, we, The Elect, through the Royal Academy and the celestial revelations of the Angels Calendar, extend a heartfelt invitation to the Vatican's leadership—Pope and bishops—to join us in spreading the true Gospel of Elohim, anchored in the Keys of the Kingdom entrusted to Peter (Matthew 16:19).

Your practice of the Mass, presented as a repeated sacrifice, stands as a modern altar to Baal, contradicting the once-for-all atonement of the Messiah (Hebrews 10:10) and keeping the faithful bound to rituals rather than freed by the Keys of the Kingdom. This deviation, rooted in man-made tradition for I will remove the names of Baal from her mouth." We call you to renounce this false worship, embrace the Keys, and restore the direct communion Elohim desires, as revealed through The Elect's teachings and the Angels Calendar's divine cycles.

If the Pope and Vatican leadership reject the Keys of the Kingdom and refuse to concede that Erick David Matthew Bennett, as Lord God, holds the divine authority to restore the true church, scripture pronounces a grave reckoning for such false shepherds. By clinging to their man-made dogmas, they perpetuate the worship of Baal, not Elohim, through practices like the Mass, which falsely repeats the Messiah's once-for-all sacrifice (Hebrews 10:10), and the veneration of saints, which elevates human intermediaries above direct communion with the Creator (1 Timothy 2:5). Yet, we extend mercy to the lay faithful, who are not condemned but invited to "come out of her, My people" (Revelation 18:4), to embrace the Keys of the Kingdom through The Elect's teachings at theelectofgod.org.
