Official Decree of The Elect of God and Royal Academy

Subject: Divine Mandate for the Purification of the Holy Land, Revelation of the Keys of David, and Fulfillment of Zechariah's Prophecy

Date: September 11, 2025

Authority: The Elect of God, Guardians of the Torah and Keys of

Preamble

Whereas the Torah, Gospel, and Quran, as divine revelations from Jehovah, establish the covenant with the true children of Israel and the faithful of all Abrahamic faiths; and whereas imposters, including those identified as "Orthodox" Jews and certain Catholic leaders, serve Baal and false gods, hiding the Knowledge of God as condemned in Quran 5:15 and 5:61–66; and whereas Zechariah 13 mandates the removal of false prophets and idols from the land, offering repentance before divine judgment; and whereas the time has come to proclaim these truths boldly to purify the Holy Land; this

decree outlines the scriptural imperatives for purging the enemies of God, as revealed in the conquest of Canaan, 1 Samuel, Nehemiah, Zechariah, the role of Islam, Joel 3, and the removal of heathens from the Holy Land.

Section I: Conquest of the Promised Land

obscure Jehovah's truth.

When the Israelites entered the Promised Land under Joshua, Jehovah commanded the eradication of Canaanite nations to eliminate their idolatrous practices, such as Baal worship, which threatened the covenant:

- Deuteronomy 7:1–2: "When the Lord your God brings you into the land you are entering to possess, and drives out before you many nations—the Hittites, Girgashites, Amorites, Canaanites, Perizzites, Hivites and Jebusites, seven nations larger and stronger than you—and when the Lord your God has delivered them over to you and you have defeated them, then you must destroy them totally. Make no treaty with them, and show them no mercy."
- **Deuteronomy 20:16–18:** "In the cities of the nations the Lord your God is giving you as an inheritance, do not leave alive anything that breathes. Completely destroy them... as the Lord your God has commanded you. Otherwise, they will teach you to follow all the detestable things they do in worshiping their gods, and you will sin against the Lord your God."
- Joshua 6:17, 21: "The city and all that is in it are to be devoted to the Lord... They devoted the city to the Lord and destroyed with the sword every living thing in it—men and women, young and old, cattle, sheep and donkeys."
 These commands ensured the Holy Land remained free from idolatry, a principle critical to countering modern imposters who

Section II: The Command to Slay All in 1 Samuel 15:3

The divine mandate to remove enemies persists, as seen in the command to Saul against the Amalekites, who opposed Jehovah's purposes:

 1 Samuel 15:3: "Now go, attack the Amalekites and totally destroy all that belongs to them. Do not spare them; put to death men and women, children and infants, cattle and sheep, camels and donkeys."

This directive underscores the necessity of decisive action against those who defy God's truth, applicable to imposters who hide the Keys of Knowledge while claiming divine authority.

Section III: Zechariah 13 and the Purification of the Land Zechariah 13 explicitly calls for the removal of false prophets and idols, aligning with the mission to expose imposters and purify the

Holy Land:

- Zechariah 13:1–2: "On that day a fountain will be opened to the house of David and the inhabitants of Jerusalem, to cleanse them from sin and impurity. On that day, I will banish the names of the idols from the land, and they will be remembered no more," declares the Lord Almighty. "I will remove both the prophets and the spirit of impurity from the land."
- **Zechariah 13:3:** "And if anyone still prophesies, their father and mother, to whom they were born, will say to them, 'You must die, because you have told lies in the Lord's name.' Then their own parents will stab the one who prophesies."
- Zechariah 13:6: "If someone asks, 'What are these wounds on your body?' they will answer, 'The wounds I was given at the house of my friends."
 - These verses foretell a day when false prophets, such as "Orthodox" leaders who rely on Talmudic and Kabbalistic traditions, will face judgment, even from their own kin, for lying in God's name. The cleansing fountain signifies repentance offered

to those who turn from falsehood, but those who persist will be removed.

Section IV: The Keys of Knowledge and Islam's Role in Confronting Falsehood

The Quran explicitly condemns those who conceal divine truth while claiming to represent God, reinforcing the urgency of revealing the Keys of Knowledge:

- Quran 5:15: "O People of the Book! Our Messenger has come to you, clarifying much of what you used to conceal of the Scripture and overlooking much. A light has come to you from Allah and a clear Book."
 - This verse announces the revelation of hidden truths (the Keys of Knowledge), exposing the falsehoods of groups like the "Orthodox" and Catholics who obscure Jehovah's teachings through Talmudic traditions or syncretic practices.
- Quran 5:61–66: "When they come to you, they say, 'We believe,' but they have entered in disbelief and left in it... If only the People of the Book had believed and feared Allah, We would have removed their misdeeds and admitted them to Gardens of Bliss. If they had upheld the Torah and the Gospel and what was revealed to them from their Lord, they would have eaten from above and below them. Among them is a righteous community, but many of them—evil is what they do."
 - These verses condemn those who claim faith but hide God's truth, promising blessings for the righteous who uphold the Torah, Gospel, and Quran, while warning of destruction for those who persist in evil.
- Deuteronomy 32:21: "They made me jealous by what is no god and angered me with their worthless idols. I will make them envious by those who are not a people; I will make them angry by a nation that has no understanding."
 - This Torah verse, alongside the Quran, supports the historical

role of Islam, raised in the 7th century to challenge corrupted religious institutions, including "Orthodox" Jews and Catholics, who hid the Keys of Knowledge. Zechariah 13:1–3 further calls for their exposure and removal, offering repentance first, as Quran 5:66 promises redemption for those who turn to truth.

Section V: Joel Chapter 3 and the Current War with Palestine The prophecy of Joel 3 addresses the eschatological conflict involving nations opposing Israel, including the current war with Palestine, and mandates action to restore the Holy Land:

- Joel 3:1–2: "In those days and at that time, when I restore the fortunes of Judah and Jerusalem, I will gather all nations and bring them down to the Valley of Jehoshaphat. There I will put them on trial for what they did to my inheritance, my people Israel, because they scattered my people among the nations and divided up my land."
- Joel 3:9–12: "Proclaim this among the nations: Prepare for war!
 Rouse the warriors! Let all the fighting men draw near and
 attack. Beat your plowshares into swords and your pruning
 hooks into spears... Let the nations be roused; let them advance
 into the Valley of Jehoshaphat, for there I will sit to judge all the
 nations on every side."
- Joel 3:19–21: "But Egypt will be desolate, Edom a desert waste, because of violence done to the people of Judah... Judah will be inhabited forever and Jerusalem through all generations. Shall I leave their innocent blood unavenged? No, I will not. The Lord dwells in Zion!"

This prophecy frames the current conflict as part of God's judgment, calling the faithful to prepare and proclaim the Keys of Knowledge to restore Judah and Jerusalem.

Section VI: Removal of Heathens from the Holy Land

Scripture mandates the removal of heathens—those who reject Jehovah and defile the Holy Land—from Israel:

- Zechariah 14:21: "Every pot in Jerusalem and Judah will be holy to the Lord Almighty, and all who come to sacrifice will take some of the pots and cook in them. And on that day there will no longer be a Canaanite in the house of the Lord Almighty."
- Ezekiel 36:24–25: "For I will take you out of the nations; I will gather you from all the countries and bring you back into your own land. I will sprinkle clean water on you, and you will be clean; I will cleanse you from all your impurities and from all your idols."
- Zephaniah 3:12–13: "But I will leave within you the meek and humble. The remnant of Israel will trust in the name of the Lord. They will do no wrong; they will tell no lies. A deceitful tongue will not be found in their mouths."
 These verses, alongside Zechariah 13:1–2, affirm that imposters

These verses, alongside Zechariah 13:1–2, affirm that imposters and idol-worshippers will be purged, leaving only the faithful remnant to worship Jehovah in truth.

Section VII: The Urgency of the Time and Call to Repentance

The time has come to speak boldly, as the Keys of Knowledge, revealed through the Torah, Gospel, and Quran (Quran 5:15), expose the falsehoods of those who claim to represent God while hiding His truth. The "Orthodox" and certain Catholic leaders, by adhering to Talmudic and syncretic traditions, commit evil in God's name, as condemned in Quran 5:61–66 and Zechariah 13:3. They are given the chance to repent, as Quran 5:66 and Zechariah 13:1 promise cleansing for those who turn from falsehood. Failure to repent will lead to divine judgment, as foretold in Joel 3, Zechariah 13:3, and Zechariah 14:21, to purify the Holy Land for the true children of Abraham.

Decree

Therefore, by the authority of The Elect of God and Royal Academy, and in accordance with the divine mandates of the Torah, Gospel, and Quran, we decree:

- 1. The true children of Israel and all Abrahamic faithful must proclaim the Keys of Knowledge (Quran 5:15) to expose imposters, including "Orthodox" Jews and Catholics, who serve Baal and hide God's truth.
- 2. In alignment with Deuteronomy 7:1–2, 1 Samuel 15:3, and Zechariah 13:1–3, the enemies of Jehovah must face judgment, with a call to repentance offered first, as per Quran 5:61–66.
- 3. The prophecy of Joel 3 mandates preparation for the current conflict with Palestine, revealing the Keys to restore Judah and Jerusalem under Jehovah's reign.
- 4. The faithful must oppose false prophets (Zechariah 13:3) and shepherds (Jeremiah 23:1–2), reform policies to exclude heathens from the Holy Land (Zechariah 14:21), and uphold the Torah, Gospel, and Quran.
- 5. The time has come to speak boldly, uniting all Abrahamic faiths to reveal the Keys of Knowledge and call imposters to repentance before divine judgment, as the cleansing fountain of Zechariah 13:1 awaits the repentant.
 Let this decree be proclaimed to the Knesset, the global Abrahamic community, and all nations, that the Holy Land may be purified and the true faith restored, as Jehovah dwells in Zion.
