

Comprehensive Lesson Plan

Title: Elohim's Sacred Lineage: Guided in Truth and Purity

Objective: Equip students to understand *Elohim*'s guidance for Their peculiar people (1 Peter 2:9), emphasizing covenant purity, racial diversity, the divine lineage of Jesus and Gabriel, and the genetic code behind Their design, with Genesis 1:27 as a foundational truth for personal discernment.

Components:

- **Website Piece**: *Discover Elohim's Sacred Lineage* (above), introducing the lesson's themes, including the Keys of Knowledge as a code and encryption for society, and its modern relevance.
- Article: Elohim's Sacred Lineage (above), polished with Think About It and Laboratory Section.
- **Discussion**: Explore Genesis 1:27, Genesis 6:2–4, Luke 1:35, Revelation 1:14–16, 1 Peter 2:9, Exodus 12:38, Nehemiah 13:3, and Ezra 9:2, connecting *Elohim*'s mating guidance to covenant fidelity, separation, and genetic preservation.
- **Activity**: Create a chart mapping traits (*admoni*, *shechorah*), figures (Jesus: white hair; Gabriel: angel), and scriptures (Genesis 1:27, Genesis 6:2–4, Luke 1:35, Exodus 12:38, Nehemiah 13:3, Revelation 1:14–16, 1 Peter 2:9).
- **Reflection**: Journal on believers as *elohim* (Psalm 82:6), teaching the Keys of Knowledge to preserve *Elohim*'s design and raise civilizations.
- **Test**: Multiple-choice test (above) to assess comprehension.
- **Premium Content (Video)**: "Elohim's Divine Lineage," exploring Jesus' glorified form (Revelation 1:14–16), Gabriel's role (Luke 1:35), Genesis 6:2–4, separation (Exodus 12:38, Nehemiah 13:3), Genesis 1:27's plural *Elohim*, and genetics, with a chart and covenant unity (Galatians 3:28–29).
- **Gentle Correction**: Modern mixing views seek unity, but scripture prioritizes covenant purity (Ezra 9:2, Genesis 6:2–4, Exodus 12:38, Nehemiah 13:3) and celebrates *Elohim*'s diverse races (Acts 17:26).

• Hebrew Analysis of Genesis 1:27:

Text: "So God created man in his own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them." (KJV)

Hebrew Breakdown:

- God: 'ĕlôhîym (אֱלֹהִים), plural, gods/goddesses (GODS GODDESSES).
- Created: bârâ' (בַּרֵא), to create (CREATED).
- Man: 'âdam (אַדַם), ruddy, human being (HUMANS).
- Image: tselem (צֵלֵם), image or likeness (IMAGE).
- **Him/Them**: 'êth (אַת), self or entity (THEY/THEM).
- Male: zâkâr (זָכֶר), male or man (MALE).
- **Female**: neqêbâh (נְקֵבָה), female (FEMALE).

Translation: CREATOR GODS GODDESSES CREATED HUMANS IMAGE IMAGE GODS GODDESSES CREATED THEY MALE FEMALE CREATED THEM.

Context: Genesis 1:26 ("Let *us* make man in *our* image") aligns "him" with the plural "us," emphasizing *Elohim*'s collective nature, creating humanity as male and female in Their likeness, affirming Abraham's lineage and all nations.

Application: Students study this verse in Hebrew to discern *Elohim*'s truth and apply it to their identity and covenant calling.

Think About It: The Bloodline of David

The bloodline of David passed through Jesus and His wife, Mary Magdalene, a high-society socialite and beautiful woman who loved her Lord. Their direct descendant restores the Hebrew Monarchy with the Keys of David today, identified by anointed lineage and distinct features.

• Laboratory Section: The Science of Genetics and Elohim's Design
The sons of God, divine beings from other stars and planets, mated with human females (Genesis 6:2–4), producing Nephilim through DNA-based reproduction. Human DNA, a binary code of nucleotides (A, T, C, G), differs by ~0.1% between races, encoding traits like admoni (red hair, MC1R gene) or shechorah (tanned beauty, SLC24A5 gene), reflecting Elohim's perfect racial designs (Acts 17:26). Mixing alters this code, potentially diluting covenant features of Abraham's lineage (light hair/eyes). The Keys of Knowledge, like DNA, are a divine code, establishing a code of conduct for society and civilizations.

- **Columns**: Traits (*admoni*, *shechorah*), Figures (Jesus, Gabriel, sons of God), Scriptures (Genesis 1:27, Genesis 6:2–4, Luke 1:35, Exodus 12:38, Nehemiah 13:3, Revelation 1:14–16, 1 Peter 2:9).
- Rows:

- **Traits**: *admoni* (Shem/Japheth, e.g., David), *shechorah* (Shem, e.g., Song of Solomon 1:5).
- **Figures**: Jesus (white hair, Revelation 1:14–16), Gabriel (messenger, Luke 1:35), sons of God (Genesis 6:2–4).
- **Scriptures**: Genesis 1:27 (plural *Elohim*), Genesis 6:2–4 (mating), Luke 1:35 (conception), Exodus 12:38/Nehemiah 13:3 (separation), Revelation 1:14–16 (Jesus' glory), 1 Peter 2:9 (covenant).
