

### Section 5: The Man Who Appears as God in the End

### **Scriptural Basis:**

- **Daniel 7:13–14**: "One like a son of man" receives an everlasting kingdom.
- Revelation 19:11–16: The rider on the white horse, called "King of Kings," embodies God's authority.
- **Zechariah 6:12–13**: The Branch, a man, will build the temple and rule as priest and king.

## **Key Points:**

- In the end times, a man appears as the embodiment of *Elohim*, fulfilling prophecy (e.g., Zechariah 6:12, the Branch).
- This man wields the Key of David (Revelation 3:7) and Knowledge of God to unite the Elect and purify the Holy Land.
- The Angels Calendar points to this figure in 2025–2026, tied to Rosh Hashanah and Israel's restoration.

- **Description**: A mini-timeline linking Daniel 7:13, Zechariah 6:12, and Revelation 19:11 to the end-time man as *Elohim*. Marks 2025–2026 as a prophetic window.
