



60-Minute Course: Unlocking the Bloodline – The Key of David

Title: Discovering the Royal Heritage: A Journey Through the Bloodline of David

Format: PDF downloadable from theelectofgod.org

Duration: 60 minutes (self-paced, with suggested timing for each section)

Objective: To explore the scriptural and historical lineage of Erick Matthew Bennett, revealing the Key of David and its role in identifying the King of Israel.

Course Outline

- Welcome and Introduction (10 minutes)
 - Content: Greet participants with a message of peace from the Lord God. Introduce Erick Matthew Bennett as the author of *It Is Written*, *Power of God*, explaining the Key of David as a tool to unlock wisdom through Hebrew letter numerology (Isaiah 22:22). Highlight the divine pattern of seven in scripture.
 - Activity: Read the opening greeting and reflect on what “turning the Key” might mean personally (2 minutes).
- Dates and Prophetic Signs (15 minutes)
 - Content: Walk through key dates tying to scripture:
 - 1917 AD (Haggai 2:1): Israel’s restoration foundation.

- 1977-1997 AD (Psalms 90:10): The lifespan prophecy.
- 2000-2012 AD (Jeremiah 51:46): Rumors of the end.
- 10/27/2017 (Malachi 4:5): Elijah's revelation.
- 10/7/2023 (Joel 3:1-2): War and gathering.
- Present Day (Isaiah 2:3): The mountain of the Lord.
- Activity: Match each date to its scripture and note how they build toward the present (5 minutes).

- The Identity and Role (15 minutes)
 - Content: Explain Erick's titles (Elijah, Eliakim, Root of Jesse) and his mission to unite Torah, Gospel, and Quran using the Key of David. Discuss Isaiah 11:2-12 and Jeremiah 23:5-8 as evidence of anointing and return.

Isaiah 11:2 And the spirit of the LORD shall rest upon him, the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and the fear of the LORD.

At the appointed time the man anointed to be king has the “spirit of the LORD” rest upon him. That means when you turn the keys to his name reveals the Power of God. The King has the spirit of wisdom and understanding meaning he teaches you the way to understand the mysteries and secret hidden things of God. The King has the spirit of counsel and might, he shows you the power in the word when you turn the keys. Your King has the spirit of knowledge and fear of the LORD. Your King teaches you the way to turn the Keys of Knowledge which is the fear of the LORD and beginning of knowledge in order for the rest of scripture to make sense. Courses will be produced about the rest of this chapter and others bringing into focus who the King is.

Two Angels and the Keys (5 minutes)

- Content: Introduce the concept of two angels (Gabriel and Jesus) from Zechariah 1-4, linking them to the restoration of Jerusalem and the Temple.

Zechariah 1:1-3

In the eighth month, in the second year of Darius, came the word of the LORD to Zechariah, the son of Berechiah, the son of Iddo the prophet, saying, The LORD has been sore displeased with your fathers. Therefore, say you to them, Thus says the LORD of hosts; Turn you to me, says the LORD of hosts, and I will turn to you, says the LORD of hosts.

The date and time is given as well as genealogy and the word of the LORD is the LORD Gabriel, God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob telling Zechariah the fathers must “turn themselves” which is turning the Keys and they will know Elohim. So we see the first aspect of recognizing your King is he is going to correct the mistakes that our fathers have been making for generations before us. The correction the King makes is by showing you the way to turn the Key of David as this restores the Hebrew monarchy and leads all the strong nations to Zion. It is the sign for them to enter in.

Zechariah 1:4-6

Be you not as your fathers, to whom the former prophets have cried, saying, Thus says the LORD of hosts; Turn you now from your evil ways, and from your evil doings: but they did not hear, nor listen to me, says the LORD. Your fathers, where they? And the prophets, do they live forever?

But my words and my statutes, which I commanded my servants the prophets, did they not take hold of your fathers? And they returned and said, like as the LORD of hosts thought to do to us, according to our ways, and according to our doings, so has he dealt with us.

So what we see is Elohim is saying Israel was punished for the sins of the fathers and the children are not to make the same mistake they did. So what is the mistake they made and how can we avoid that? Excellent question. Stay tuned..

- Activity: Write Genesis 1:1, count its 7 words, and consider its divine structure (2 minutes).
- Call to Action and Closing (5 minutes)
 - Content: Encourage participants to share this knowledge, support the Aaliyah to Zion, and prepare for the day of the Lord. Offer a prayer for peace.
 - Activity: Write a short commitment to learn more about the Keys (2 minutes).
