

Welcome to Celestial Reproduction

Introduction: Shalom! Elohim's reproductive plan bridges heaven and earth, from Genesis 6's Nephilim to Gabriel's conception of Jesus (Luke 1:35) and Erick Matthew Bennett's divine offspring. This course explores scripture, science, and prophecy to reveal Elohim's lineage, preparing you for Zion's restoration in 2025–2026!

Celestial Reproduction:

- **Sons of God**: Genesis 6:2–4, celestial beings from other planets mated with women, producing Nephilim (e.g., Goliath, 1 Samuel 17:4).
- Gabriel and Mary: Luke 1:35, Gabriel "overshadowed" Mary, conceiving Jesus, a son of God. Gematria: Gabriel (Γαβριήλ) = 154.
- Erick Matthew Bennett: As a Lord God (Psalm 82:6), fathered two children, plans more in the Mediterranean (Malachi 4:5, Elijah).
- **Science**: DNA's binary code, ~0.1% variation, supports hybridization (MC1R gene, red hair).
- Historical Evidence: Sumerian tablets (2000 BCE), Egyptian "Shasu of YHVH" stele (1400 BCE).
