



Welcome to Covenant Purity and Elohim's Diverse Creation

shalom! Genesis 10, the Table of Nations, shows Noah's sons—Shem, Ham, Japheth—spreading Elohim's plan after the Flood (~2348 BCE). This course explores covenant purity (Ezra 9:2) and diverse traits, using scripture, genetics, and history to equip you to teach Elohim's design!

Table of Nations:

- Shem: Middle East, admoni (1 Samuel 16:12, David).
- Ham: Africa/Asia, shechorah (Song of Solomon 1:5).
- Japheth: Europe, light skin, blonde/red hair, blue/green eyes (Acts 17:26).
- Japheth's seven sons (Genesis 10:2): Gomer (Caucasus), Magog/Tubal/Meshech (Russia), Madai (Iran), Javan (Greece), Tiras (Europe).
- Gematria: Yefet ($70 = 7 \div 490$) $490 = 10+80+400 = (\text{יפת}, \text{perfect cycle})$.

• Covenant Purity:

- Ezra 9:2, Nehemiah 13:3: Separation protects Abraham's lineage (1 Peter 2:9, light hair/eyes).
- Genetics: ~0.1% racial variation, MC1R gene (red hair, admoni).
- Historical evidence: Midianite pottery (~1400 BCE), Egyptian "Shasu of YHVH" stele.

• Activity:

- Map Noah's sons to regions/traits on a world map.
- Debate: "How does covenant purity align with Elohim's diversity?" (5 minutes).
