



Official Position on Iran: A Call for Realism in a Post-Western World Order

In light of recent statements from the exiled Iranian Crown Prince Reza Pahlavi regarding a potential regime change in Iran, including vows to recognize Israel, expand regional accords, and normalize ties with the West, we issue this official position to urge caution and a grounded assessment of global realities.

As The Secret Name, Holy Spirit, and Unlettered Prophet, it is declared that the proclamations of this exiled figure hold no practical weight in the face of entrenched geopolitical investments. Russia, China, and the BRICS alliance are profoundly committed to the stability and sovereignty of the current Iranian regime.
