**Lesson Title: How Different Minds Engage the Same Truth –
Genesis 1:1**



Goal:

To experience how a single short verse unfolds with ever-greater richness as we engage our minds more deeply. This lesson emphasizes growth, humility, and mutual respect. No level of engagement is “better” than another — only different depths of perception are available to all who seek.

Core Verse (same translation for all participants):

“In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.”

(Genesis 1:1)

Five Stages of the Lesson**Step 1: Open in Unity (5–7 minutes)**

- Welcome everyone and read the verse slowly together (aloud, 2–3 times).
 - Short prayer or moment of silence: “Father, open our minds and hearts to Your Word.”
 - Set the tone: “Today we explore how we think, not what we believe. All responses are valuable. There are no wrong answers.”
 - Quick icebreaker (go around the room or group): “What is the very first thing this verse makes you feel or picture?” (Keep answers brief — 30 seconds each.)
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Stage 1 – Basic / Concrete Processing (8–10 minutes)

Description: Simple recall, literal meaning, and immediate personal associations — like a young reader or someone hearing the verse for the first time.

Activity:

Participants write or share their own Stage 1 response in 1–2 sentences.

Example responses:

- “God made the sky and the ground right at the start.”
- “It’s the very first sentence in the Bible about how everything began.”
- “It makes me think of a big hand creating the world like a child draws a picture.”

Discussion Prompt: “What is good and helpful about seeing it this simply? When is this way of thinking powerful?”

Stage 2 – Understanding & Context (10–12 minutes)

Description: Adding basic background, sequence, and meaning. We connect the verse to what we already know.

Activity: Invite participants to “level up” their response to Stage 2.
Example responses:

- “This tells us God is the Creator who started everything. It introduces the six days of creation that follow. ‘In the beginning’ means time itself had a start.”
- “It sets the foundation for the whole Bible — God is not part of the world; He made the world.”
- “It answers ‘Where did everything come from?’ with one clear answer: God.”

Discussion Prompt: “What new understanding did you gain by adding context? How does this stage help the verse make more sense?”

Stage 3 – Analytical / Pattern Recognition (12–15 minutes)

Description: Examining language, structure, contrasts, and logical implications. Asking “Why these words?” and making comparisons.

Activity: Level up again to Stage 3 responses.

Example responses:

- “The Hebrew word bara (created) is used only for God’s unique action — something from nothing. This verse stands against ancient myths of gods battling chaos.”
- “It establishes one God, not many. The phrase ‘the heavens and the earth’ is a Hebrew way of saying ‘everything that exists.’”
- “It raises deep questions: If there was a beginning, what was before? This points to a God outside of time.”

Discussion Prompt: “What patterns or deeper meanings did you notice? How does slowing down and analyzing change the way the verse lands in your mind?”

Stage 4 – Synthetic / Integrative (10–12 minutes)

Description: Connecting across disciplines — theology,

philosophy, science, and broader Scripture — seeing unity and divine purpose.

Activity: Level up responses to Stage 4.

Example responses:

- “This verse aligns with Big Bang cosmology (a definite beginning) while declaring purposeful creation by a personal God. It bridges faith and reason.”
- “Philosophically, it answers infinite regress — something outside time caused time. Theologically, it foreshadows John 1:1–3 and unifies creation under one sovereign Elohim.”
- “Numerically, the Hebrew structure (7 words, 28 letters) reveals divine order (multiples of 7), pointing to perfection in design.”

Discussion Prompt: “How does integrating different fields enrich the verse? What connections surprised you?”

Stage 5 – Contemplative / Creative Wisdom (10 minutes)

Description: Personal application, holding mystery, leading to transformed living, prayer, or creative expression.

Activity: Level up to Stage 5 (journal, draw, pray, or share).

Example responses:

- “This humbles me daily — my ‘beginnings’ (new days, projects) mirror the Creator’s. I’m called to bring order from chaos in my life and community.”
- “A prayer: ‘Father, as You created from nothing, renew my heart and use me in restoring Your order.’”

- Creative: Draw light breaking through darkness, or write a short poem on new beginnings.

Full Group Reflection & Closing (8–10 minutes)

1. Which stage felt most natural to you today?
 2. What helped you move from one stage to the next?
 3. How can we practice going deeper without dismissing simpler ways of seeing?
- Re-read the verse one last time.
 - Close with a short prayer of thanks for the gift of minds that can grow.
 - Takeaway: “The same truth can be simple, clear, or profound — depending on how deeply we choose to look. Truth unfolds in layers — simple hearts and deep seekers both belong at the table.”

New Scenario: Math Word Problem – Introducing the Keys of Knowledge & House of David

Objective: Demonstrate how even a simple math problem can open doors to spiritual revelation when processed through the Layers of the Mind. The Keys of Knowledge (Hebrew letters = numbers) unlock patterns such as the Power of Seven (777) in Genesis 1:1, pointing to the Key of David (Isaiah 22:22; Revelation 3:7) that restores the House of David.

Math Word Problem (present after re-reading Genesis 1:1):
“A divine blueprint has 7 foundational words with a total numerical value of 2701. The nouns within it sum to 777. If a disciple seeks the ‘Keys of Knowledge’ to unlock the House of David, and each

key multiplies understanding by 7 (the number of perfection), how many layers of revelation open when starting from the basic sum and applying the Keys three times? What does this reveal about restoration?"

(Note: Inspired by gematria patterns in Genesis 1:1 — 7 words / 28 letters / nouns totaling 777 — symbolizing divine order and the alphanumeric code restoring monarchy and unity.)

Apply the Five Stages to the Math Problem

(Use the same stage descriptions above, adapted to the math problem)

- **Stage 1:** "7 words add up to something big. 777 is special. Multiply by 7 a few times and you get bigger numbers. It's about God's perfect math."
- **Stage 2:** "This problem uses numbers from Genesis 1:1. 777 represents completeness. The Keys turn letters into numbers to see hidden messages. It points to opening doors for the House of David, like a king's authority restored."
- **Stage 3:** " $2701 \div 37 = 73$ (a known Genesis 1:1 code). $777 \div 7 = 111$. Applying $\times 7$ three times: $777 \times 7 = 5439$; $\times 7 = 38073$; $\times 7 = 266511$. Patterns of 7 reveal intentional design... The Key of David (Rev 3:7) opens what no one shuts."
- **Stage 4:** "Mathematically, this mirrors fractal patterns and prime structures in creation. Theologically, it unites Torah, Gospel, and revelation as a universal code... It calls for restoring the House of David as a unifying monarchy under divine numeric witness."

- **Stage 5:** “These Keys humble me: God’s math is perfect, my understanding grows layer by layer. I commit to using this revelation for healing divisions and co-creating order.”
(Include prayer or creative expression: Draw a key with 7 gems unlocking a house labeled ‘David.’)

Facilitation Tips:

- Always begin with Genesis 1:1, then move to the math problem.
 - Emphasize that anyone can learn the Keys (provide simple letter-to-number charts).
 - Discussion: “How does numeric revelation deepen faith without replacing the heart?”
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The Symbol of Zeta Zayin
